Transport – Students Policy

PURPOSE OF THE POLICY

The purpose of this policy is to provide students with a clear understanding of the standard of behaviour that is expected by the Rockhampton Girls Grammar School when students are travelling on the School buses or on public transport.

POLICY

Context

Girls travelling on the School buses or public transport must remember that, as they are representing the School in the wider community, their behaviour must be of the highest standard. Older students should help to ensure that the younger members of the School community adhere to the following policy principles.

Policy Principles

Students must behave in a way that ensures the safety and comfort of all travellers. The following safety principles must be followed at all times.

- Hands etc must be kept totally within the bus.
- Seat belts, if available, must be worn.
- Noise should be kept to a minimum.
- All heavy items of luggage should be stowed under the seats.
- Girls must remain seated until the bus is completely stationary before disembarking.
- Girls must ensure that the bus is left tidy at the end of each journey
- The drivers should be spoken to politely and all their instructions carried out immediately.

Public Transport

It is expected that students will abide by the above principles when travelling on any public transport e.g. buses, trains, planes.
