Uniform Policy

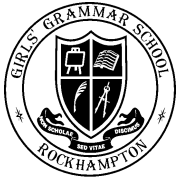
PURPOSE OF THE POLICY

The purpose of this policy is to give clear direction to the wearing and handling of school uniforms at Rockhampton Girls Grammar School.

POLICY

Students **MUST** wear dress uniform to and from school including panama. Sports uniform is only permitted to be worn to and from events on Sports Carnival days. The RGGGS uniform includes the following:

1. **Years Prep – 6** wear the School dress.
2. **Years 7-12** may wear either the dress or the skirt and shirt. Years 7–12 will wear skirt combination and blazer as formal wear.
3. **Dress – all terms:** may be worn with regulation white socks or navy coloured tights. The length of the dress should come to the top of the knee.
4. **Skirt – all terms:** to be worn with regulation white blouse and tie. As day wear may be worn with white socks or navy coloured tights. **As formal wear, to be worn with navy coloured tights only, (as purchased from the Uniform shop) and blazer.** The length of the skirt should come to the bottom of the knee.
5. **Sports uniform:** the sports shirt and shorts must be worn for Physical Education practical lessons. Students need to change into and out of this uniform before and at the completion of these lessons. Dance students must wear $\frac{3}{4}$ black leggings under their PE shorts.
6. **Swimwear:** The RGGGS bathers are a compulsory uniform item.
7. **Hat:** is to be worn to and from school, and at anytime during the day when in the sun. **Years 7 – 12:** panama with gold and navy hatband with School logo at front. **Years 1 – 6:** navy hat with School badge embroidered in gold at front.
8. **Hair ties:** Hair styles and hair colour should be conservative and neat. Hair longer than shoulder length should be worn tied back. Only navy blue (or school tartan) hair ties, ribbons, scrunchies or headbands may be worn.
9. **Tie – Years 1 – 11:** is cross-over, plain blue fabric to be worn on the dress and formal shirt. **Year 12:** tie is navy with 5mm gold ribbon near edge to be worn on the dress and formal shirt.
10. **Badges:** School badge to be worn in centre of tie at cross-over or collar of dress. Prefect badges and Senior badges will be similar. Helen E Downs and Prue McKeague badges, Prefect and Senior badges to be worn in centre of tie instead of standard School badge. House badges to be worn on right side of the tie (House badges are not to be worn on formal group occasions). Badges from other sources are **NOT** to be worn except during designated fundraising/awareness raising periods. Name badges should be worn each normal school day on the left side of the School tie.
11. **Tights** will be Razamatazz 40 Denier Soft opaque or Girl's opaque in 'Ink Navy'.
12. **Socks** will be standard white fold-down cotton (not sports) – as available from the P & F shop.
13. **Shoes** will be standard black lace up school shoes as per the type in stock in the P & F Shop. (Deck shoes, boots or chunky heel styles will not be allowed.) Sports shoes for Physical

Education must be predominantly white and designed for physical activity (not Dunlop Volleys).

14. **School Bags:** From 2012 the RGGGS School bag will be a compulsory uniform item. There are a number of designs to choose from at the P & F Uniform shop. Please note that laptop computers must be carried in the computer bag supplied.
15. **Lanyards:** These safety release lanyards should be worn in preference to other designs and will be the only lanyards permitted from 2012.
16. **Jewellery:** A simple watch and 1 pair only of sleepers OR studs (plain gold or silver), if ears are pierced, to be worn in the lower lobe of the ear only.

ALL STUDENTS MUST POSSESS AT LEAST ONE OUTFIT OF THE FORMAL UNIFORM

The School uniform is a symbol of our community and part of the proud tradition of the School. As such, there is no place for a combination of a uniform and current fashion trends.
